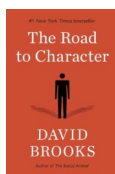

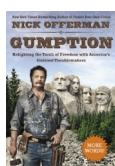
## Two Books with Demetri

Using character studies of nine people in fields ranging from pop culture to politics Brooks draws fifteen codes of humility for living an authentic life today.



### **Gumption** by Nick Offerman

Nick Offerman is probably best known for his role as Ron Swanson on *Parks and Recreation*. In *Gumption*, Nick tells the story of people that he considers "America's greatest mischief makers," from George Washington to Barney Frank to Conan O'Brien. Much more lighthearted than *The Road to Character* but just as telling in a different way, Offerman admires people who have the wherewithal to take big risks and be successful and ethical about it.
