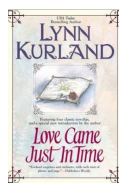
Creatology will give kids in grades 4, 5, and 6 opportunities to work hands-on with art, technology, and music.

Blind Date with a Book

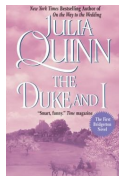

Love in the Stacks

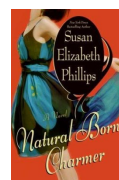
Whatever kind of romance you're looking for, we're sure to have it! Circulation staff members have suggested some favorite authors covering a variety of genres:
