Goo, Maureen. **Somewhere Only We Know** **ON ORDER**

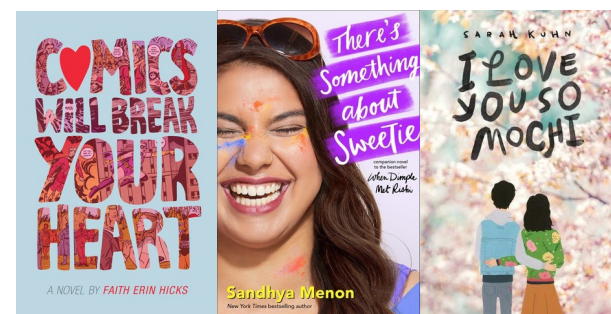
